

Privacy and cookie policy

§ 1 general principles

1. This Privacy Policy sets out the processing principles and methods of protection personal data, including personal data of people using the store on the website www.nowaszkola.com , belonging to the company Nowa Szkoła Sp. z o. o. with the headquarters in Łódź.
2. This Privacy Policy is an integral part and attachment to the Regulations of the Online Store.

§ 2 Personal Data Administrator

1. The administrator of personal data of the Online Store on the website www.nowaszkola.com is the company Nowa Szkoła Sp. z o.o. with the headquarters in Łódź at ul. POW 25, entered into the Register of Entrepreneurs kept by the District Court for Łódź-Śródmieście in Łódź, 20th Department of the National Court Register with number KRS 0000109353, REGON 471014170, NIP 7250013378, BDO 000050986. The company has capital share capital in the amount of PLN 1192500.00 in full.

§ 3 Protection of personal data

1. The administrator of personal data uses technical and organizational measures ensuring protection in the processing of personal data in accordance with requirements contained in applicable regulations on the protection of personal data (General Data Protection Regulation) - Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council dated on 27.04.2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (GDPR), and the Polish act of law of Personal Data Protection, dated on the 10th of May 2018.

§ 4 The purposes of processing personal data by the Administrator

1. Personal data are processed by the Administrator in the following purposes:
 - a. Performance of the contract or order
The data is processed on the basis of - art. 6 clause 1 point b) and c) GDPR.
 - b. newsletter
The data is processed on the basis of - art. 6 clause 1 point a) GDPR.

c. business contacts

The data is processed on the basis of - art. 6 clause 1 point f) GDPR.

d. organization and promotion of trainings and conferences

The data is processed on the basis of - art. 6 clause 1 point f) GDPR.

e. answer to the question

The data is processed on the basis of - art. 6 clause 1 point a) GDPR.

f. compliance with the legal obligation to draw up and store documentation

The data is processed on the basis of - art.6 par.1 point c) GDPR.

§ 5 Legal basis for data processing

1. The legal basis for the processing of your personal data by Data Administrator can be:

- a. Your consent: in the case of data collection based on consent, you have the right to withdraw consent in any time. Withdrawal of consent does not affect legal compliance processing based on consent before her withdrawal.
- b. Performance and settlement related to the contract or order: the administrator may process personal data in in connection with the performance of a contract to which you are a party. In case of data processing for this purpose may not be entitled to objection or, if it is filed, it will be impossible performance of such a contract or order. Still, however the right to access and correct such data, as well as others the rights described later in this information.
- c. Implementation of the legal obligation incumbent on the Administrator.
- d. in some situations, the Administrator is required on the basis of provisions of the law to collect certain personal data, in in particular to fulfill the obligations related to accounting and financial reporting. In these situations you do not have the right to object to the processing data or the right to request their removal. It still has You have the right to access and correct such data as well other rights referred to later in this information.
- e. Implementation of the Data Controller's legitimate interests: the administrator may process your personal data for the purpose implementation of the Administrator's legitimate interests, unless they prevail over them your rights and freedoms. In particular The administrator may process personal data for the purpose of keeping correspondence and providing you with information, but also in to protect the legitimate interests of the Administrator and other persons.

2. The administrator does not transfer data to a third country / organization international. Your personal data may be transferred entities providing goods transport and processing services necessary personal data in this regard at the request of the administrator.

3. The data will be stored for the time necessary to achieve the purpose. The data will be processed for the period of legally justified existence administrator's interest. Data will not be profiled. Pass data is voluntary, but necessary to achieve the stated purpose.

4. The data subject has the right to access their data, theirs rectification, deletion, processing restrictions, transfer, objection, withdrawal of consent. Exercise of the rights arising from the above records is closely related to the conditions for the exercise of these rights described in GDPR. You have the right to lodge a complaint in any time supervisory authority, which is the President of the Office for Data Protection Personal information.

§ 6 Definitions

1. Cookies - means IT data, in particular small files text, saved and stored on devices, via which the User uses the Website's pages.

2. Administrator's Cookies - means Cookies published by Administrator, related to the provision of electronic services by Administrator via the Website.

3. External Cookies - means Cookies placed by partners Administrator, via the Website's website.

4. Website - means the website or application under which the Administrator runs a website operating in the domain of www.nowaskola.com

5. Device - means an electronic device through which The User gains access to the Website.

6. User - means the entity for whose benefit, in accordance with the Regulations and legal regulations may be used to provide services electronically or with which may be concluded a Contract for the provision of electronic services.

§ 7 Types of Cookies used

1. Cookies used by the Administrator are safe for the Device User. In particular, this route is not possible to reach Users' devices of viruses or other unwanted software or malware. These files allow you to identify software used by the User and customize the Website individually for each User. Cookies usually contain a name the domain from which they originate, their storage time on the Device and assigned value.

2. Entity placing on the Website User's end device cookies and Website administrator accessing them.
3. The administrator uses two types of cookies:
 - a. Session cookies: they are stored on the User's Device and remain there until the end of the browser session. After at the end of the session, the saved information is permanently deleted from memory Devices. The mechanism does not allow session cookies any personal data or any confidential information from User's devices.
 - b. Persistent cookies: they are stored on the User's Device and remain there until they are deleted. End of given session browsers or turning off the Device does not delete them from User's devices. The mechanism of persistent cookies does not allow downloading any personal data or information confidential from the User's Device.
4. The user has the option of limiting or disabling file access cookies for your device. If you use this option using the Website will be possible, except for functions which by their very nature require cookies.

§ 8 The purposes for which Cookies are used

1. The Administrator uses Administrator's Cookies for the following purposes:
 - a. Website configuration:
 - recognition of the Website User's device and his Website location and display, respectively adapted to his individual needs,
 - font size, website appearance, etc.
 - b. Implementation of processes necessary for full functionality of the websites web:
 - adaptation of the Website content to User preferences and optimizing the use of websites Website. In particular, these files allow recognize the basic parameters of the User's Device and properly display the web page adapted to his individual needs.
 - c. Analysis and research as well as audience audit:
 - create anonymous statistics that help you understand in how Website Users use websites Website, which allows improving their structure and content.
 - d. Ensuring the safety and reliability of the website.

§ 9 Possibilities to specify the conditions for storage or access by Cookies

1. The user can change settings in any time regarding Cookies, specifying the conditions for their storage and gaining access to the User's Device via Cookies.

Changes settings referred to in the previous sentence, the User can make via web browser settings or via configuration services. These settings can be changed in particular in such a way to block the automatic handling of cookies in the settings Internet browser or inform about them every time placing Cookies on the User's device. Detailed information about the possibilities and ways of handling cookies are available in the settings software (web browser).

2. The User may delete Cookies in any time using available functions in the web browser it uses.

3. Restricting the use of cookies may affect some functionalities available on the Website.

4. The administrator informs that the settings change in the web browser Users may affect access to some features of the site Website, e.g. by limiting them.

§ 10 How to disable the storage and handling of "cookies" in your browser?

1. Responsible for handling and storage of "cookies" directly the internet browser you use. By default, browsers have enabled the handling and storage function "Cookies".

2. If you do not agree to the storage of cookies, you can disable this function in the web browser options by changing the settings for storing cookies by her.

3. In mobile phones, tablets and other devices: each model phone, tablet or other device with a browser Internet may support this function in a different way. That is why we encourage to familiarize yourself with the privacy options in the device documentation on manufacturer's website.
